Invoicing

Fee concessions, exemptions and refunds

For any 12 month period, an Australian Apprentice is eligible for a fee concession if they;

- · hold a current Health Care Card or Pension Card, or
- can prove genuine financial hardship.

For any 12 month period, an Australian Apprentice is eligible for a fee exemption if they;

- changed Registered Training Organisation, or
- changed employer.

For any 12 month period, an Australian Apprentice is eligible for a refund if;

- training was not delivered or made available by us, or
- they were overcharged.

Learners are advised of the availability for concessions, exemptions and refunds during the induction process. Applications for a concession, exemption or refund, can be made in person or in writing (including email).

Actions arising from non-payment of fees

Where the appropriate fees have not been paid, certification may be withheld from the student as per clause 3.3 *Standards for Registered Training Organisations (RTOs)* 2015

Where the appropriate fees have not been paid, learners may have future enrolments denied.
